CANDIDATE CHECKLIST

- A. As a candidate, you must file a Statement of Interest prior to collecting any nomination petition signatures. Any nomination petition signatures collected before the date you submit the Statement of Interest are invalid and may be subject to challenge pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-351.
- B. You must file a Statement of Organization to form a Candidate Committee within ten days of meeting the committee criteria. (For additional requirements and restrictions refer to ARS § 16-905.)
- C. Petitions have been furnished for the signatures required. Refer to ARS § 16-321, for completion of petitions.
- D. The election will be held on July 21, 2026 pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-311, the following properly executed forms must be submitted to the Town Clerk for the official filing of your candidacy no more than 150 days before the primary election (no earlier than 8:00 AM, February 21, 2026) and not less than 120 days before the primary election (no later than 5:00 PM, March 23, 2026):
 1. Petitions containing no less than 147 valid signatures or more than 294 signatures [ARS § 16-311(B)].
 2. The Nomination Paper, Declaration of Qualification, and a Campaign Finance Statement included in the Declaration that states you have no final, outstanding judgments against you of more than an aggregate of \$1,000 due to your failure to comply with or enforcement of Title 16, Chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes (signed under penalty of perjury).
 3. The Financial Disclosure Statement (prescribed by the Secretary of State).
