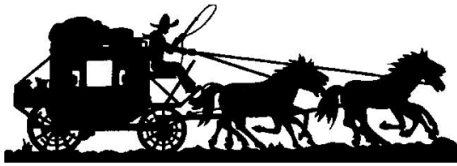
Town of Wickenburg to Host America 250 Traveling Museum and Community Celebration

Wickenburg, AZ — The Town of Wickenburg is proud to host a stop of the America 250 Traveling Museum on Thursday, February 19, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Stone Park, as part of the nationwide commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States. The event is free and open to the public.

The America 250 Traveling Museum offers an engaging and educational experience that explores the nation's founding, civic ideals, and Arizona's unique role in America's story. Exhibits include interactive displays, historical storytelling, and a rare opportunity to view a replica of the Liberty Bell, a powerful symbol of freedom and independence.

A formal presentation will take place at noon, featuring remarks from the Mayor and Wickenburg Town Council, officially marking Wickenburg's participation in the America 250 commemoration. The formal presentation will include live musical performances, including the Hassayampa Elementary School Coyote Chorus and Lance Kramer of the Wickenburg Marshals, adding a distinctly local and historic touch to the celebration.

Joining the Traveling Museum is the Time Capsule Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit and America & Arizona 250 community partner, bringing an interactive AZ250 Time Capsule exhibit. Visitors can contribute messages, reflections, and aspirations to be preserved for the future in a sealed capsule that will be on permanent display at the Arizona Heritage Center in Tempe until 2101. The exhibit also features a Legacy Wall, DNA examples, and a "Mind File" demonstrating how messages are preserved on a laser-etched disk.
