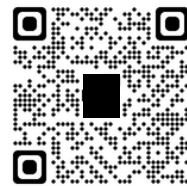

BUILDING PERMIT PROCESS

PROJECTS THAT NEED A PERMIT

- new residential construction
- new commercial construction
- manufactured/modular home placement
- building/room additions
- garage, storage shed, awning, deck
- carport, vehicle shade, breezeway, patio
- swimming pool, spa
- retaining wall over 18", fence, pool barrier fencing
- grading
- electrical, plumbing, gas line, mechanical work
- demolition of a structure

PROJECTS THAT DON'T NEED A PERMIT

- replacing tile or shingle roofs
- paint (interior/exterior); repair drywall, plasterboard, paneling or stucco (insulated stucco systems require a permit)
- replacing heat pumps or water heaters
- flat work such as landscaping, or concrete and paver driveways
- patio slabs or sidewalks
- low-voltage landscape accent lighting
- gazebos or pergolas that are under 200 sq ft that do not include electric, gas, or plumbing
- Minor repairs or replacement of non-structural items such as glass, doors, hardware, kitchen cabinets, carpeting, flooring or trim work.
- repair existing landscape irrigation
- repair/replace existing plumbing fixtures in the same location

THE PERMIT PROCESS

What is needed (in PDF format only):

- detailed site plan with utility locations
- construction plans
- fire sprinkler plans (if applicable)
- Owner Builder Statement (if applicable)
- grading and drainage plans (if applicable)
- Flood Use Permit (if applicable)

Approval of permit or questions concerning your permit application will come via email.

Once approved you will be sent a payment link to pay online.

Upon successful payment, your permit will be sent to you via email for you to sign and upload to the portal.

*We do not accept paper plans.
The permitting process is all digital.*

WHY DO I NEED A PERMIT?

Building permits ensure that work is performed according to building safety codes and the Town's zoning ordinances. Permits protect you, your family, your home, and the community.

If it is determined you have begun a project without a permit when one is required, a double permit fee will be assessed as a penalty. Obtaining a permit in the beginning will save you a headache, time, and money.

In some cases, lenders will verify permits were issued prior to funding a loan.
